

3-HOUR TRAINING COURSE

Life-Threatening Bleeding Control

This course provides essential guidance on controlling life-threatening bleeding, including the safe and effective use of tourniquets and haemostatic dressings. It highlights the inherent risks involved and equips participants with the knowledge and confidence to respond effectively in critical situations.



Entry requirements

Learners must hold a valid First Aid at Work or Emergency First Aid at Work certificate to attend this course.

Syllabus

The course covers a range of topics, including:

- Equipment
- Primary survey
- Life-threatening bleeding
- Haemostatic dressings
- Tourniquets
- Top-to-toe survey
- Environmental issues
- Handover to the emergency services

Certification

There is no formal examination. However, learners will be continuously assessed by the trainer throughout the course. A non-regulated certificate of achievement will be awarded to those who demonstrate the required level of competence.

Numbers

A maximum of 16 students can be accommodated on this course.

Age limit

Learners must be at least 16 years of age to attend the course.
